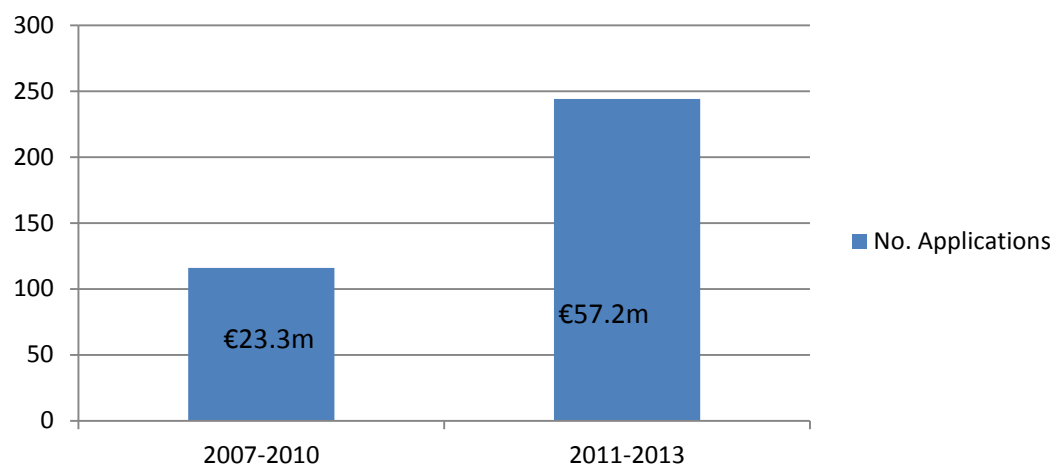

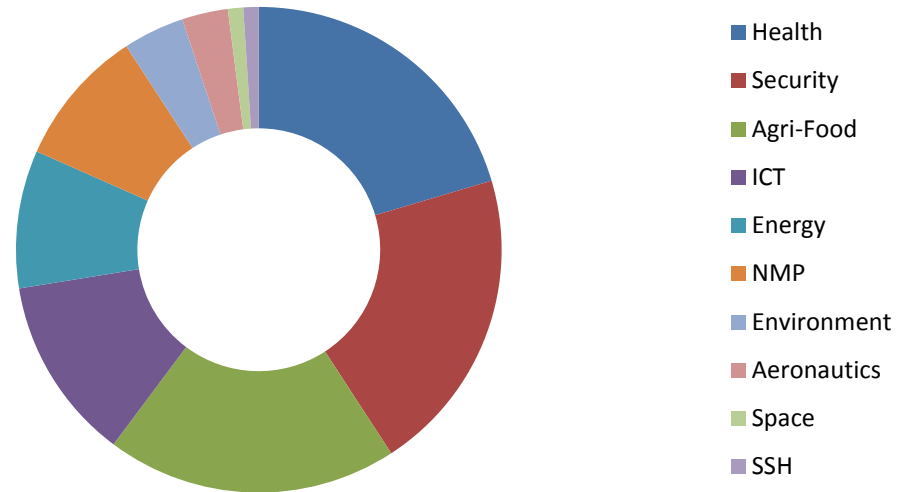

North/South Collaboration in FP7

As of July 2013 Marie-Curie is one of the top 5 areas for North South collaboration in FP7 accounting for more than 10% of the total drawdown of North South projects



The total drawdown from FP7 projects with participants from Ireland and Northern Ireland as of July 2013 is valued at **€80.5m**, which is distributed among the 89 successful N/S projects.

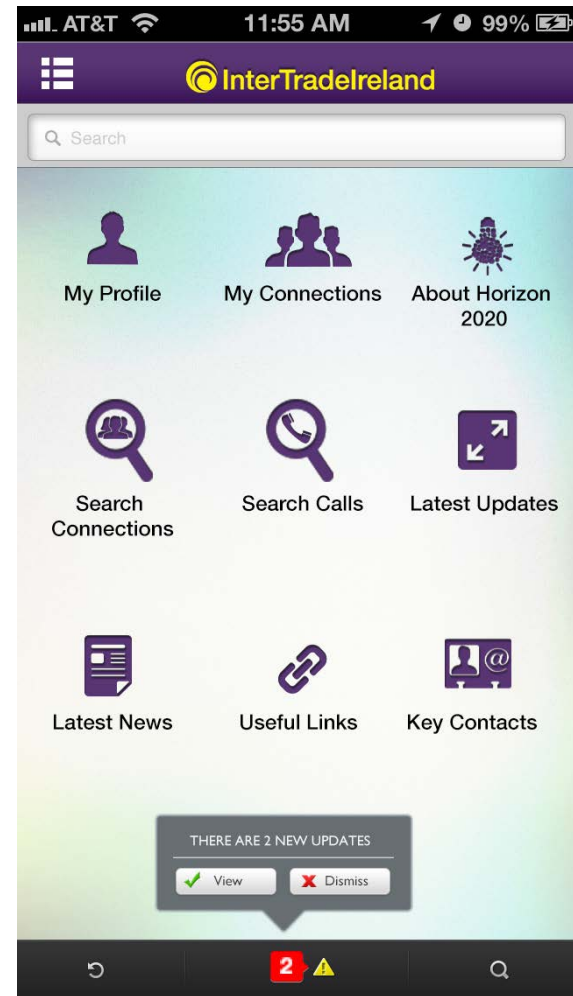
